Rules & Regulations

The organizers

1. The organization of the World Championship Youth 2024 has been allotted by the FMJD to the Polish Draughts Society (Stowarzyszenie Polskie Towarzystwo Warcabowe).

Schedule

2. Schedule of the event will be published shortly before. The main frameworks are as follow:

Thursday, October 24th arriving day

20:00 technical meeting with coaches and chefs of delegations

Friday, October 25th opening, 1st round

Friday, November 1st WCY Rapid

Saturday, November 2nd WCY Blitz

Sunday, November 3rd departure day

Participants

4. There will be 10 separate official World Championship Tournaments:
 - 4.1. Juniors Boys Open (B19) - boys born 1st of January 2005 or later.
 - 4.2. Juniors Girls (G19) - girls born 1st of January 2005 or later.

- 4.3. Cadets Boys Open (B16) - boys born 1st of January 2008 or later.
 - 4.4. Cadets Girls (G16) - girls born 1st of January 2008 or later.
 - 4.5. Mini Cadets Boys Open (B13) - boys born 1st of January 2011 or later.
 - 4.6. Mini Cadets Girls (G13) - players born 1st of January 2011 or later.
 - 4.7. Hopes Boys Open (B10) - boys born 1st of January 2014 or later.
 - 4.8. Hopes Girls (G10) - girls born 1st of January 2014 or later.
 - 4.9. Young Stars Boys Open (BYS) - boys born 1st of January 2016 or later.
 - 4.10. Young Stars Girls (GYS) - girls born 1st of January 2016 or later.
5. Girls are allowed to play in open groups.
 6. Maximal number of players from one country in the same group in classical draughts is 3 plus optionally 1 sponsor place (see p. 8)
 7. Organizer gets one extra place in each category, can add a player to a group to make even number of players and can also use a sponsor place (see p. 8). Maximum 6 players in each category may represent organizer.
 8. **Sponsor places:** 10 places per country (one in each category). Amount for one place is equal 200 € (to be paid to Polish Draughts Society). Additionally players need to pay competition fee and cost of accommodation. Federation interesting in must send a document before September 10th.
 9. **Rapid and blitz tournaments are open.** It means that there are no limit of players from one country in the same category.

Disciplines

10. Classical draughts with games rate:
 - 10.1. Groups B19, G19, B16, G16 - 90' for first 45 moves and after + 30' + 30''/move (Fischer)
 - 10.2. Groups B13, G13, B10, G10 – 80' + 60''/move (Fischer)
 - 10.3. Groups BYS, GYS – 90' + 30''/move (Fischer)
11. Rapid with games rate: 15' + 5''/move (Fischer)
12. Blitz with games rate: 5' + 3''/move (Fischer)

Technical details

13. Number of rounds to be confirmed by the main referee in the technical meeting.
14. The official software Draughts Arbiter will be used.

National team classification

15. The national team classification is based on individual results of players representing their national federation.
 - 15.1. The best 3 players from one country in the final classification obtain points in each age group, the calculation is done by percentage score + bonus points for top 10 places (bonus points exactly like in World Cup: 1st - 100, 2nd - 70, ..., 10th - 20). Example - 6 points out of 9 rounds and 21st place gives 33 points for the country. 1st place with 15 points gives 183 points (100 + 83).
 - 15.2. There will be separate classifications in classic, blitz and rapid championships, in each classification results of boys and girls groups will be counted together

Competition fee

16. Competition fee (according to FMJD Internal Regulations): Classic 25 €, Rapid 10 €, Blitz 10 €

18. September 10th it is a deadline to pay competition fee.

Accommodation

19. Hotel charges (with breakfast/dinner/supper):
 - 19.1. Total amount per person per day (in double or larger rooms) is equal:
 - 19.1.1. **52 €** for player
 - 19.1.2. **57 €** for accompanying person
 - 19.1.3. Price for single room: **75 €** per person per day. Number of single rooms is limited.

19.2. Free hospitality (paid by the organisers)

19.2.1. for each 3rd player from the same federation in the group. Means – if 1 or 2 players in the group - all must pay; if 3 players in the group, one place is for free.

19.2.2. If federation did not get free places on the condition above - then one player from whole delegation will be for free.

19.2.3. Means – at least one competitor from each federation will receive a free hotel.

21. September 10th it is a deadline to pay.

22. Accommodation is possible only in the hotel provided by organizer. Entry to the playing venue is not possible for those who lives in another places.

23. Payment in cash can be made but it cost 10€ extra per person and it must be agreed in advance with organizer by email.

Applications and its validity

24. Applications:

24.1. Registration for participation in tournaments is possible **only by online registration** which will be available on FMJD website from 15th of August. For further details (login and initial password) please contact with office@fmjd.org.

24.2. For accommodation, visa applications – must be sent from National Federation (1 federation=1 document) using attached file (2411_WCY_Application). One person who will be present during the event, must be nominated in this application as a Chief of delegation. If visa invitation is needed, please include proper data into file 2411_WCY_Application and provide scans of passport. Applications must be sent from National Federation at the address magda.pawlowska@fmjd.org (with a copies to office@fmjd.org) with a deadline on September 10th

25. Application is not valid:

25.1. if information's are not completed.

25.2. if fee is not paid.

25.3. if accommodation is not paid.

28. In case of insufficient number of hotel rooms, accommodation in another hotel provided by organizer is possible (price will remain the same)

29. Transport

29.1. Closest airport: Wroclaw, Prague.

29.2. The train station "Szklarska Poręba Górna" is 600 meters away

29.3. Transport from/to airport, train or bus station in Wroclaw can be organized by CTD.
